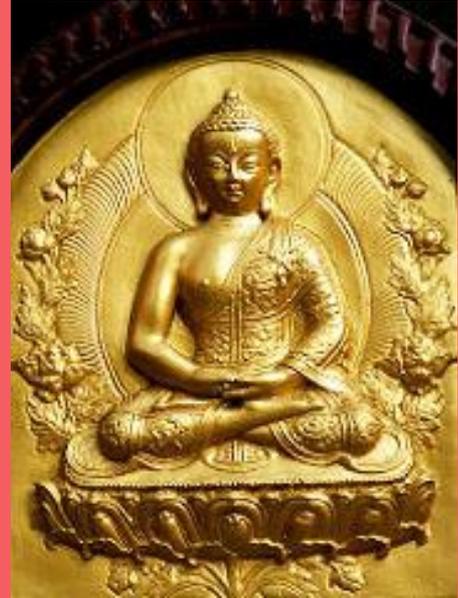


Stories of the Buddha
