Mantra from "The Sutra of Great Liberation"

NAMO BUDDHĀYA / NAMO DHARMĀYA / NAMAḤ SANGHĀYA / ADANTI DHĀRAŅĪ / TADYATHĀ / AKAŚHANI VĀVĪNI / SARVA DHARMĀ NI VANĪ / IŚHAMANA / VIPAŚHANA / VIMALA SUPARI / DHARMA NI KHANA / VARUNI CHAYA TAMALE / CHALE / HULU HULU / ŚHIVITE / MANTRA MANTRA Ḥ SVĀHĀ

This was taught by 8,000 billion buddhas. If you criticize this mantra, you criticize all these buddhas and enlightenment cannot be achieved. If with devotion you hear this mantra or you recite it only one time a day, until enlightenment is achieved you will not be reborn in the three lower realms and you will achieve enlightenment gradually. This is the truthful advice of the unbetraying Victorious One.
